All ages are encouraged to attend and participate!

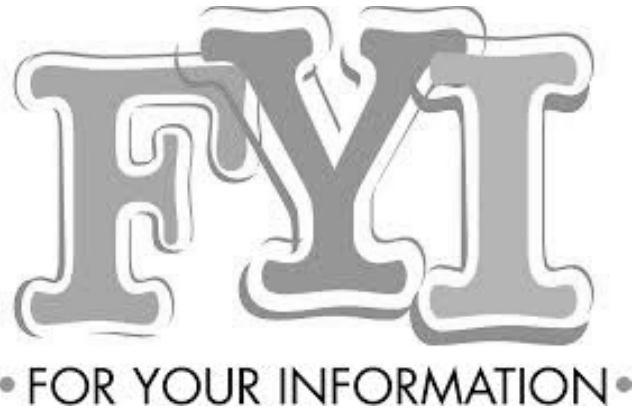
Community of Care

Spaghetti Casserole

| 1-1 1/2 pounds ground beef | 8 ounces cream cheese, softened |
| salt and pepper to taste | 1/4 cup sour cream |
| 1 small onion, chopped | 8 ounces cottage cheese |
| 2 cloves of garlic, minced | |
| 2 24-ounce jars marinara sauce | 3 cups shredded mozzarella cheese, divided |
| 16-ounce package spaghetti | |
| 8 tablespoons butter | |

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a skillet, cook beef. Season with salt and pepper. Add onions and garlic, and cook until onion is translucent. Drain. Stir in 1 jar of marinara sauce. Set aside. Cook spaghetti according to package instructions. Place hot spaghetti in a bowl and stir in 1 jar of marinara sauce. Place 4 tablespoons butter in 9-by-13 inch pan. Pour half the pasta into the pan. Combine cream cheese, sour cream, cottage cheese, and 1 cup mozzarella cheese in a bowl and mix well. Smooth over pasta in the pan. Top with 4 slices butter and remaining pasta. Add meat mixture on top, and smooth into a layer. Top with remaining cheese. Bake for 35--40 minutes or until hot and bubbly. If cheese browns too fast, cover with foil. Let sit 15 minutes before cutting.
