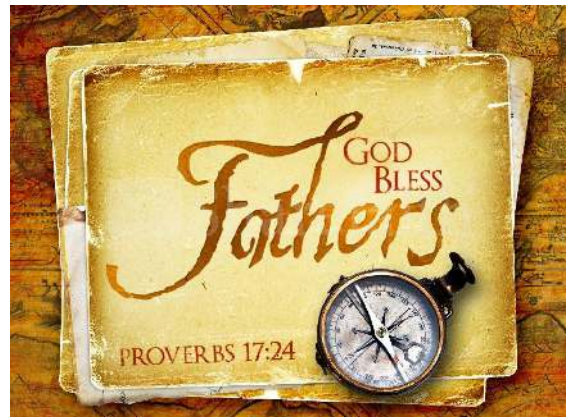

NASHVILLE (BP) -- This summer, kids will seek animals in rainforests, grasslands, frozen tundra and even the Rocky Mountains with "In the Wild," the 2019 Vacation Bible School theme from LifeWay Christian Resources.

In the Wild will have kids embark as photographers seeking to snap pictures in settings decorated to mimic animals' natural habitats. Along the way, kids will also learn about real-life encounters people had with Jesus and discover how biblical snapshots of the Savior provide an opportunity to respond to the Gospel.

"This is going to be such a fun theme," said Melita Thomas, VBS specialist for LifeWay. "It's a photo scavenger hunt in the wild where it's possible to see absolutely anything."

As kids explore different locales on the lookout for wildlife, they'll also study eyewitness accounts of Jesus from the Gospels -- stories to help them zoom in and focus on Christ.

"All of these 'snapshots' of Jesus that we see in Scripture were recorded so we might believe Jesus is who He said He is -- the Messiah, the Son of God," Thomas said. "These eyewitness accounts are a strong apologetic -- one that kids need to hear."

VBS remains one of the most popular church programs in America, LifeWay Research shows. Six in 10 Americans say they went to VBS growing up, and 95 percent of parents whose child attended VBS say it provided a positive experience.

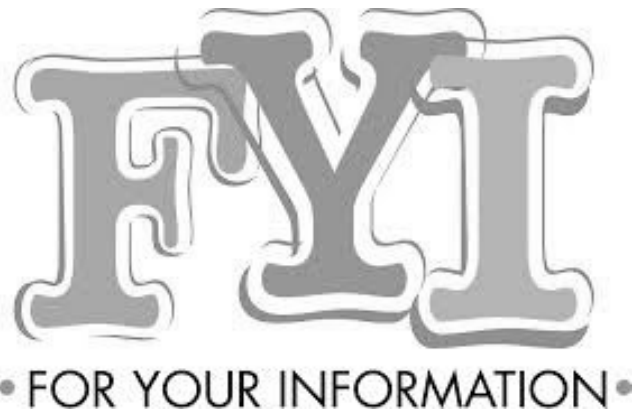
"Last summer, more than 70,000 people made professions of faith as a direct result of VBS," Thomas said, citing data from the Southern Baptists' Annual Church Profile (ACP).

Chili Dog Tater Tot Casserole

1 pound ground chuck
 15-ounce can mild chili beans
 15-ounce can tomato sauce
 4 turkey dogs, cut into small slices
 2 teaspoons chili powder
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon garlic powder
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon onion powder
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon red pepper flakes
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup finely chopped onion
 3 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese, divided 32-ounce package tater tots

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease 9-by-13-inch baking dish. Brown ground chuck. Drain. Add chili beans, tomato sauce, hot dogs, and seasonings. Combine. Spoon mixture into baking dish. Sprinkle onion and 2 cups cheddar cheese on top. Arrange tater tots on top of the cheese (may not use whole package). Bake 30 minutes. Remove and sprinkle with remaining 1 cup cheese. Return to oven for a few minutes to melt the cheese.

Blueberry Muffins

1 cup all-purpose flour	2 large eggs
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar	1 cup sugar
$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cinnamon	1 cup vanilla Greek yogurt
1 stick butter, softened	1 teaspoon vanilla extract
2 cups all-purpose flour	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup canola oil
3 teaspoons baking powder	1 cup blueberries
$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt	1 tablespoon flour

Preheat oven to 400°. Grease muffin tins. Combine 1 cup flour, $\frac{2}{3}$ cup sugar, and $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cinnamon. Add softened butter and stir with a fork until crumbly. Set aside. In a large bowl, combine 2 cups flour, baking powder, and salt. In another bowl, mix eggs and 1 cup sugar. Whisk in yogurt, vanilla, and oil. Fold wet ingredients into dry ingredients and mix. In a small bowl, toss 1 cup blueberries with 1 tablespoon flour until berries are coated. Fold blueberries into batter. Spoon batter into prepared muffin tins, filling cups about $\frac{2}{3}$ full. Sprinkle streusel on top of each muffin. Reduce heat to 375° and bake 18 to 20 minutes or until toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
