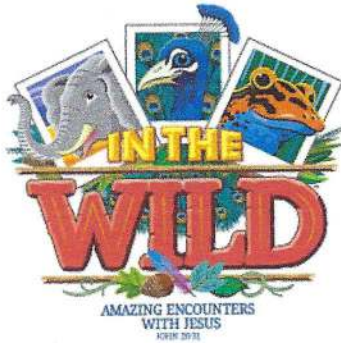

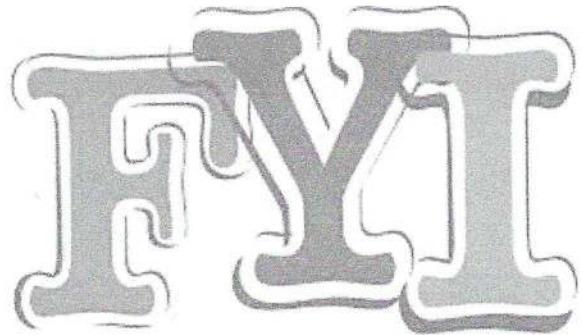

Jalapeno Chicken Chili

3 tablespoons oil, divided	1½ cups chicken broth
½ small onion, diced	14-ounce can
3-4 tablespoons diced	cannelloni beans,
jalapeno peppers	drained
3 cloves garlic, minced	14-ounce can corn,
salt and pepper to taste	drained
¼ pounds chicken breasts,	8 ounces cream
cut into small pieces	cheese, cubed
2 teaspoons chili powder	½ pound bacon,
1 teaspoon cumin	cooked crisp
1 teaspoon oregano	and crumbled
pinch of crushed red pepper	shredded cheese
10-ounce can mild Rotel®	

In a large saucepan, heat 2 tablespoons oil over medium heat and sauté onion, jalapeno, and garlic until tender. Season chicken with salt and pepper. Toss chicken with seasonings and lightly brown in additional oil. Stir in Rotel, broth, beans, and corn. Simmer for about 30 minutes. Stir in cream cheese until melted. Stir in bacon. Remove from heat. Add salt and pepper if necessary. Add more chicken broth if too thick. Top with grated cheese.

White Chocolate Crispy Treats

20-24 ounces white chocolate almond bark
1 cup peanut butter
4 cups Rice Krispies®
12-ounce jar unsalted peanuts
6-ounce bag of mini marshmallows

Melt white chocolate using package directions. Pour into a large bowl. Combine with peanut butter and stir until blended. Pour in remaining ingredients and mix until well coated. Drop by spoonfuls onto waxed paper. Let sit until hardened. Makes approximately 40.
