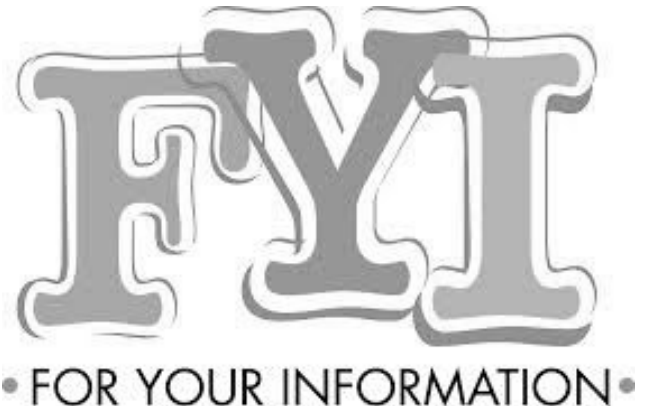

Key Lime Pie Bars

2 cups graham cracker crumbs
3 tablespoons sugar
pinch salt
8 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
6 ounces cream cheese, room temperature
14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk
4 egg yolks
1/2 cup lime juice
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
whipped cream (optional)
lime slices (optional)

Preheat oven to 350°. Line a 9-by-9-inch pan with parchment paper; set aside. In a bowl, mix crumbs, sugar, salt, and butter. Press crumbs into the bottom of the pan. Bake 10 minutes. In a large bowl, beat cream cheese until smooth. Mix in condensed milk. Add egg yolks one at a time, mixing well after each. Add lime juice and vanilla, and mix until combined. Pour filling in crust. Bake 15-18 minutes or until set. Remove from oven. Place in refrigerator for 4 hours before serving. Serve with whipped cream and a slice of lime if desired. Serves 9-12.

Taco Soup

1 pound ground chuck
1 medium onion, chopped
1 package taco seasoning mix
1 package Hidden Valley® Ranch dressing mix
16-ounce can kidney beans, undrained
16-ounce can chili beans, undrained
16-ounce can whole kernel corn, undrained
16-ounce can petite diced tomatoes, undrained
1 can Ro*Tel, undrained
1 can beef broth
Optional toppings: sour cream, shredded cheddar cheese, chopped green onions, corn chips

Brown meat and onion; drain. Transfer to a large pot and add remaining ingredients (except toppings). Let simmer for about 1 hour. Optional: After cooking and draining meat and onion, add all ingredients (except toppings) to slow cooker and cook on low for about 4 hours. Add sour cream, shredded cheese, chopped onions, and/or corn chips to bowls when served. Serves 8-10.



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
