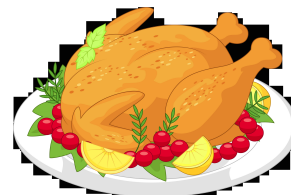

No-Churn Vanilla Ice Cream

- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk

Using a mixer with a whisk attachment, beat heavy cream until it starts to thicken. Add vanilla. Beat until some soft peaks form. Add condensed milk while beating, and continue to beat about 5 minutes to incorporate air and make stiffer peaks. Transfer to a freezer-safe container. Cover with plastic wrap, pressing wrap down to the ice cream mixture. Freeze at least four hours before serving in scoops.

Makes about 4 cups.

Low Sugar Peanut Butter Cookies

| 2 tablespoons butter | $\frac{3}{4}$ teaspoon baking soda |
| 1 cup natural peanut butter | $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon baking powder |
| 2 tablespoons brown sugar | $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chocolate chips |
| 2 tablespoons white sugar | |
| 2 eggs | |
| 1 tablespoon milk | |
| 1 teaspoon vanilla | |
| $1\frac{1}{4}$ cups flour, preferably whole wheat | |

Preheat oven to 350 F. In a saucepan over low heat, melt together the butter, peanut butter, and sugars. Move mixture to a large bowl. Your mixture should only be warm, not hot. Once it's just slightly warm, add eggs, milk, and vanilla. Sift dry ingredients (flour, baking soda, and baking powder) into wet ingredients, and stir until combined. Stir in chocolate chips. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Form dough into golf-ball sized balls, and place on sheet; press down slightly. Bake 7-8 minutes. Cookies will set as they cool. Cool on baking sheet 5 minutes before transferring to a cooling rack. Best served warm! Makes approximately 18 cookies
