Assistance was given to 5 families as follows:

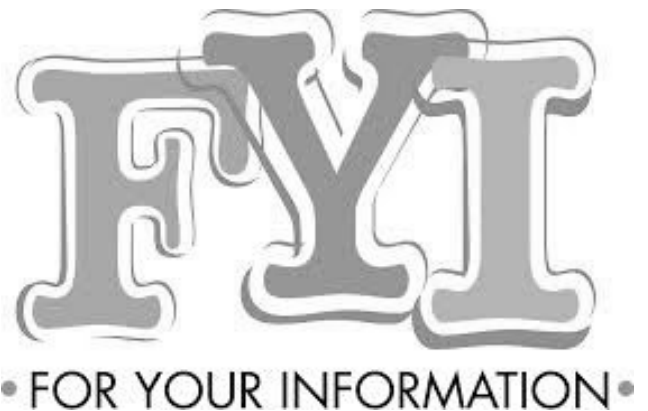
Utility assistance: \$572.19

Low Sugar Peanut Butter Cookies

2 tablespoons butter	$\frac{3}{4}$ teaspoon baking soda
1 cup natural peanut butter	$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon baking powder
2 tablespoons brown sugar	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup chocolate chips
2 tablespoons white sugar	
2 eggs	
1 tablespoon milk	
1 teaspoon vanilla	
$1\frac{1}{4}$ cups flour, preferably whole wheat	

Preheat oven to 350° F. In a saucepan over low heat, melt together the butter, peanut butter, and sugars. Move mixture to a large bowl. Your mixture should only be warm, not hot. Once it's just slightly warm, add eggs, milk, and vanilla. Sift dry ingredients (flour, baking soda, and baking powder) into wet ingredients and stir until combined. Stir in chocolate chips. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Form dough into golf-ball sized balls, and place on sheet; press down slightly. Bake 7-8 minutes. Cookies will set as they cool. Cool on baking sheet 5 minutes before transferring to a cooling rack. Best served warm! Makes approximately 18 cookies.

Mango Upside-Down Cupcakes

1 cup white sugar
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water
 6 tablespoons butter
 2 cups diced mango, fresh or frozen
 1 yellow cake mix and ingredient to prepare according to directions

Preheat oven to 350 F. Combine 1 cup sugar and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water in a small saucepan over low heat. Stir until sugar is mostly dissolved. Bring to a boil over medium heat, and let boil without stirring until the sugar turns amber. Remove from heat; add butter and swirl in by shaking the pan. When butter is fully incorporated, pour into 24 muffin cups evenly. Set aside to cool. When caramel is slightly hardened, divide mango pieces among the cups, pressing slightly into the caramel. Prepare a yellow cake mix according to box instructions. Spoon or scoop the batter on top of the mangoes in the muffin cups. Cook cupcakes 25-30 minutes, until a tester comes out clean. Cool 10-15 minutes; then invert onto a plate or cooling rack. Makes 24 cupcakes.
