Jesus Is My Valentine

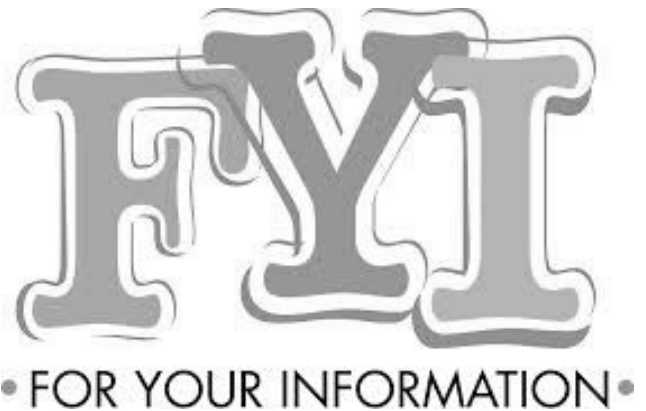
Jesus is my Valentine;

HEALTHY MORNING MUFFINS

1¹/₄ cups all-purpose flour
3³/₄ cup ground flaxseed
1¹/₂ cup packed brown sugar
1¹/₂ teaspoon baking soda
1¹/₂ teaspoon baking powder
1¹/₂ teaspoon ground nutmeg
1¹/₂ teaspoon ground cinnamon
1¹/₂ teaspoon salt
2 large carrots, shredded
1 ripe banana, mashed
2 eggs
1¹/₃ cup milk
2 tablespoons canola oil
2 tablespoons peanut butter
1¹/₂ cup pecan pieces

Preheat oven to 375°F. Grease a 12-cup muffin tin or line with papers. In a bowl, combine flour, flaxseed meal, brown sugar, baking soda, baking powder, nutmeg, cinnamon, and salt. Mix well. In another bowl, combine carrots, banana, eggs, milk, oil, and peanut butter. Add flour mixture and pecan pieces. Stir just until combined. Do not overmix. Fill muffin tins two-thirds full. Bake for 15 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean. *Makes 12 muffins.*

SHRIMP DIP

2 pounds freshly boiled shrimp, peeled, deveined, and finely chopped
2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, softened
1 cup mayonnaise
2 tablespoons chili sauce
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
1 medium yellow onion, finely grated
juice of 1 to 2 lemons, to taste
salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste

In a glass bowl, mix together shrimp, cream cheese, mayonnaise, chili sauce, Worcestershire sauce, onions, lemon juice, and salt and pepper. Refrigerate for 1 to 2 hours before serving.

Makes 3¹/₂ to 4 cups, depending on shrimp size.
