

At our March 18, 2024 meeting, the following was reported for the year of 2023:


Assistance was given to 7 families as follows:

Broccoli Cheddar Soup

1/4 C. melted butter
1/2 medium chopped onion
1/4 C. flour
2 C. half-and-half cream
2 C. low-sodium chicken

2 C. low-sodium chicken stock or broth

3 C. broccoli, chopped into

bite size pieces
1 C carrot, julienned
1/4 tsp. nutmeg
2 C. grated sharp cheddar
cheese

Melt the 1/4 cup butter and sauté the onions in it until soft. Sprinkle the flour over the mixture. Cook and stir over medium heat for 1-2 minutes. Whisk in the half & half and chicken stock. Add the broccoli and carrots. Cook over low heat for 20-25 minutes or until the broccoli and carrots are tender. Add salt and pepper to taste. Add the cheese.

Vegetarian Enchilada Bake

1 C. shredded zucchini
1 T. finely chopped sweet ¹/₈ tsp. ground cumin red pepper ³/₄ C. salsa
1 tsp. olive oil 2 T. minced fresh cilantro
1 garlic dove, minced 3 corn tortillas, 6 inches
3/4 C. frozen corn ³/₄ C. shredded 3/4
C. black beans, cheddar cheese rinsed and drained Sour cream, optional

Preheat oven to 350°F. In a large skillet, sauté zucchini and pepper in oil until pepper is crisp-tender. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Add the corn, beans, salt and cumin; sauté 2-3 minutes longer. Stir in salsa and cilantro. Place a tortilla in the bottom of a 1-1/2-qt. round baking dish coated with cooking spray. Spread with 2/3 cup vegetable mixture; sprinkle with 1/4 cup cheese. Repeat layers twice. Bake, uncovered, until heated through and the cheese is melted, 20-25 minutes. Let stand for 10 minutes before serving. If desired, serve with sour cream.
