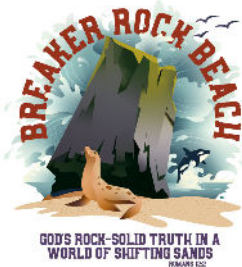

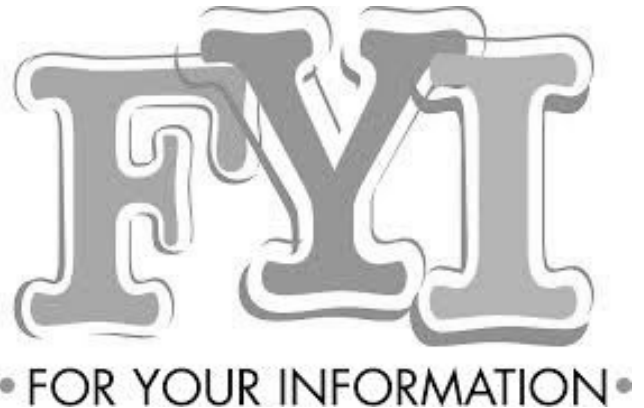

### Classic Three Bean Salad

Kosher salt	½ C. chopped red onion
1 lb. fresh green beans, trimmed	2 T. chopped parsley
1 15-oz. can cannellini or other white beans, drained and rinsed	Dressing:
1 15-oz. can red kidney beans, drained and rinsed	1/3 C. olive oil
½ C. chopped celery	¼ C. red wine vinegar
	Juice of 1 lemon
	1-1/2 tsp. kosher salt
	½ tsp. ground black pepper

For the salad: Heat a large pot of water over high heat and bring to a boil. Season generously with salt. Add the green beans and cook for 3 to 5 minutes, until tender, but still have a slight crunch. Drain in a Colander and rinse well under cold water until cool. Chop into 1-inch pieces. For the dressing: In a large bowl, whisk to combine the olive oil, red wine vinegar, lemon juice, salt and black pepper. Added the cooled green beans, cannellini beans, kidney beans, celery, red onion, and parsley to the bowl with the dressing. Toss well to combine and serve.

### Stuffed Pepper Soup

1 8.8 oz. pkg. ready-to-serve long grain and wild rice	1 26 oz. jar chunky tomato paste sauce
1 lb. ground beef	1 14-1/2 oz. can Italian diced
2 C. chopped green peppers	tomatoes, undrained
1 C. chopped onion	1 14 oz. can beef broth

Prepare rice according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan, cook the beef, green peppers and onion until meat is no longer pink, crumbling beef; drain. Stir in the pasta sauce, tomatoes, broth and prepared rice; heat through.
