Broccoli Salad

8 C. broccoli cut into bitesized pieces

 $^{1}/_{3}$ C. red onion diced

¹/₂ C. dried cranberries

 $^{1}/_{4}$ C. sunflower seeds

 $^{1}/_{2}$ C. bacon bits

Dressing

1 C. mayonnaise

3 T. cider vinegar

2 T. sugar

salt & pepper to taste

Whisk together dressing ingredients in a medium bowl. Set aside. In a large bowl, combine broccoli, onion, cranberries, sunflower seeds, and bacon bits. Pour the prepared dressing over and mix well. Refrigerate for at least one hour before serving.

Stuffed Pepper Soup

- $1\ 8.8\ \text{oz.}$ pkg. ready-to-serve long grain and wild rice
- 1 26 oz. jar chunky tomato pasta sauce
- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 14-1/2 oz. can Italian diced tomatoes, undrained
- 2 C. chopped green peppers
- 1 C. chopped onion
- 1 14 oz. can beef broth

Prepare rice according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan, cook the beef, green peppers and onion until meat is no longer pink, crumbling beef; drain. Stir in the pasta sauce, tomatoes, broth and prepared rice; heat through.
