

Chicken Salad Veronique

4 split chicken breasts, bone-in, skin-on Good olive oil Kosher sale and freshly ground pepper ½ C. mayonnaise
½ T. chopped fresh tarragon leaves
1 C. small-diced celery
1 C. green grapes, cut in ½

Place the chicken breasts, skin side up, on a sheet pan and rub them with olive oil. Sprinkle generously with salt and pepper. Roast for 35 to 40 minutes, until the chicken is cooked through. Set aside to cool. When the chicken is cool, remove the meat from the bones and discard the skin and bones. Cut the chicken into a ¾ inch dice. Place the chicken in a bowl; add the mayonnaise, tarragon leaves, celery, grapes, 1½ to 2 teaspoons salt and 1 teaspoon pepper and toss well.

Ranch Trail Mix Snack Mix

3 C. Rice Chex cereal
3 C. Corn Chex cereal
2 C. pretzels
1 C. cheddar crackers
1 C. peanuts

1/2 C. butter, melted
1 packet ranch
seasoning mix
1/2 tsp. garlic powder
1/2 tsp. onion powder

Preheat your oven to 250 degrees and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. In a large mixing bowl, combine the cereal, pretzels, crackers and peanuts. In a small bowl, mix the melted butter with the ranch seasoning, garlic and onion powder. Pour the seasoned butter over the cereal mix and toss until everything is well-coated. Spread the mixture in an even layer on the prepared baking sheet. Bake for 1 hour, stirring every 15 minutes.
