Cajun Potato Soup

5 Yukon gold potatoes, peeled and cut into chunks

1 T. olive oil

1 green bell pepper, chopped

1 lb. andouille smoked sausage, cut into round slices

1 C. heavy cream

1/4 C. grated Parmesan cheese

2 T. butter

1 yellow onion, chopped

2 stalks celery, chopped

2 cloves garlic, chopped

4 C. vegetable broth or chicken broth

1 tsp. Cajun seasoning, or as needed

Place potatoes in a large microwave-safe bowl with a few table-spoons of water, and cook on High, stopping occasionally to stir potatoes, until nearly tender, 5 to 8 minutes. Meanwhile, heat butter and olive oil in a large stock pot over medium heat. Add onion, celery, bell pepper, and garlic, and cook and stir until onion begins to turn translucent, about 5 minutes. Stir in andouille sausage, and cook for about 5 minutes more. Pour in vegetable broth; bring to a simmer, add potatoes, and cook until potatoes are fork-tender, about 15 minutes. Stir in cream; season to taste with Cajun seasoning, and cook just until heated through. Serve hot in bowls; sprinkle each bowl with Parmesan cheese.

Rhubarb Muffins

3/4 C. sugar
3/4 C. brown sugar
1/2 C. vegetable oil
1 C. buttermilk, or milk + 1 T. vinegar
1 egg
23/4 C. flour
1 tsp. baking soda
3 C. diced rhubarb
Topping:
1/2 C. sugar
1/2 tsp. cinnamon

1 egg ½ tsp. cinnamon 1 tsp. vanilla extract 1 T. butter, softened

Preheat oven to 350°F and line 24 muffin cups with liners. In a large bowl, stir together sugar, brown sugar, oil, buttermilk, egg, and vanilla. Add flour and baking soda, stirring until just combined. Fold in diced rhubarb. In a small bowl, mix together sugar, cinnamon, and butter with a fork until combined. Fill each muffin cup 2/3 full with batter. Top each muffin with about 1 teaspoon of the cinnamon sugar

Bake for 18-22 minutes. Remove from the muffin tin and cool on a wire rack.
