Community of Care

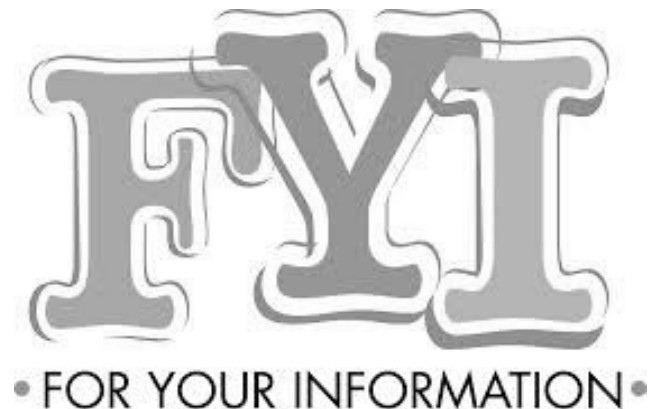
The Creighton Community of Care will be the hands and feet of Christ and respond to needs in the Creighton area, guided by Matthew 25:35-40.

Quick & Easy Baked Zucchini

1.2 lb. zucchinis, 4 large, 5 medium	½ tsp each salt and pepper
2 T. olive oil	2 T. breadcrumbs
	2 T. parmesan

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F with the oven shelf set high in the oven. Trim the ends off the zucchini. Cut medium zucchinis in quarters lengthwise, and large ones into sixths (halve then cut each half into 3 lengthwise to make 6 long "wedges"). Pile zucchini on a tray. Drizzle with 1 tablespoon olive oil, salt and pepper. Toss. Line up in two rows so they're touching each other, with the skin side down. Sprinkle evenly with breadcrumbs, then parmesan, drizzle with 1 tablespoon oil. Bake 12 minutes until the parmesan is golden and zucchini is soft but not soggy.

Cherry Turnovers

1 pkg puff pastry, 2 sheets	1 T. milk
1 C. fresh or canned cherry pie filling	1 C. powdered sugar
1 egg	1 tsp. vanilla extract
	2-3 T. milk

Preheat oven to 400° F. Thaw the puff pastry sheets according to package instructions and roll them out on a lightly floured surface. Cut each sheet into 4 squares.

Place 1-2 tablespoons of cherry filling in the center of each square. Fold the pastry over to make a triangle and press the edges to seal. Use a fork to crimp the edges.

In a small bowl, beat the egg with the tablespoon of milk. Brush this mixture over the tops of the turnovers.

Place the turnovers on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Bake in the preheated oven for 15-20 minutes or until golden brown.

While the turnovers are baking, mix the powdered sugar, vanilla extract, and 2-3 tablespoons of milk in a bowl to make the glaze. Adjust the milk for desired consistency. Once the turnovers are done and cooled slightly, drizzle the glaze over them.
