

California Carrot Cake

2 C. sugar 1 C. vegetable oil 3 eggs 2 C. flour 2 tsp. baking soda ½ tsp. salt 2 tsp. cinnamon 8-oz. can crushed pineapple, do not drain1 C. chopped nuts

Frosting:

 $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. salt 8 oz. cream cheese 2 tsp. cinnamon 1 lb. powdered sugar 2 C. shredded carrots 2/3 stick softened butter

1 C. shredded coconut

Mix the sugar and oil. Beat in the eggs, one at a Time. Add the flour, soda, salt and cinnamon. Mix thoroughly. Fold in carrots, coconut, pineapple and nuts. Pour in a greased and floured 9x13 cake pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 55-60 minutes. Mix frosting ingredients and spread on cake.

Sourdough Bread

 $\frac{1}{2}$ C. sugar $\frac{1}{2}$ C. starter $\frac{1}{2}$ C. oil $\frac{1}{2}$ C. water $\frac{1}{2}$ T. salt $\frac{1}{2}$ C. flour, approx.

Mix above with enough flour to make a stiff dough. Knead and then place in a greased bowl. Turn over to grease top. Cover with cloth and let rise until double or overnight.

Punch down and knead 8-10 times. Divide into 3 parts. Place in 3 greased loaf pans or divide in half and make into rolls and place in 2 9x13 greased pans. Grease tops with oil. Let rise overnight or until double.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30-45 minutes for loaves or 15-20 minutes for rolls.
