

Pumpkin Crisp

4 C. pumpkin purée, fresh or canned

1 C. sugar

1 tsp cinnamon

½ tsp ground ginger

½ tsp ground cloves

½ tsp ground nutmeg

1/4 tsp salt

1 C. flour

½ C. old-fashioned oats

½ C. brown sugar

½ C. unsalted butter, melted

1/4 C. chopped pecans, optional

Preheat to 350°F. Lightly grease a 9x13-inch baking dish. In a large bowl, mix the pumpkin purée, sugar, cinnamon, ginger, cloves, nutmeg and salt. Pour the mixture into the prepared baking dish and spread it evenly. In a separate bowl, combine the flour, oats, brown sugar, and pecans. Pour in the melted butter and stir until crumbly. Sprinkle the crumble mixture evenly over the pumpkin layer. Bake for 40-45 minutes or until the topping is golden brown and the pumpkin mixture is set.

If you have not heard, I was blessed with the opportunity to serve our church as the associate pastor. This church has been a blessing to many over the years, and it is exciting to see how the Lord is working within our church.

In August we wrapped up the last of summer break and our youth are back to school. Let us pray for a great school year where they will grow in wisdom and stature. We started our Wednesday night youth ministry and rebranded it. It is now known as S.A.L.T (Students are leaders too), our theme verse is 1 Timothy 4:12. We meet Wednesdays at 5:30pm.
