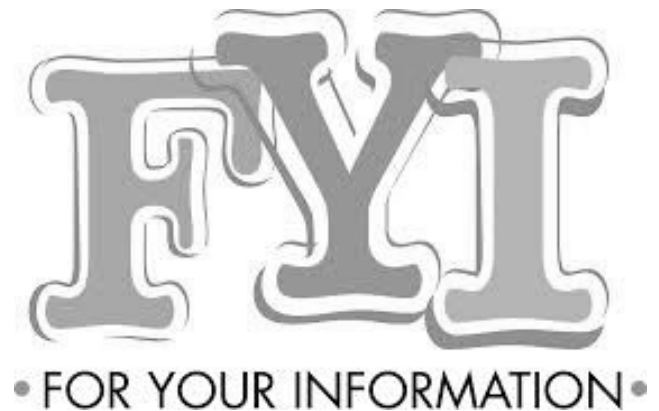
The Creighton Community of Care will be the hands and feet of Christ and respond to needs in the Creighton area, guided by Matthew 25:35-40.

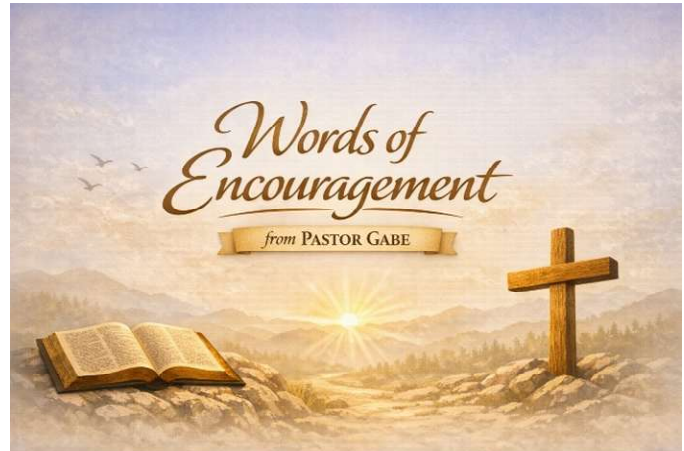

May is the month we celebrate Mother's Day and take a moment to reflect on the amazing work mothers do; moms you are seen and appreciated; your work does not go unnoticed, thank you for all you do. Corn Chowder

1 large onion, chopped	and cut into ½-inch cubes
½ C. butter	2 C. milk
2½ C. water	1½ tsp. salt
2 14¾ oz. cans cream style corn	¾ tsp. pepper
4 medium potatoes, peeled	Minced fresh parsley

In a Dutch oven, sauté onion in butter until tender. Add the water, corn and potatoes; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 16-20 minutes or until potatoes are tender. Reduce heat to low. Stir in the milk, salt and pepper. Cook for 5-10 minutes or until heated through, stirring occasionally. Sprinkle with parsley.

Ham Salad

1½ lbs. boneless cooked ham diced	2 tsp. onion, finely chopped
1 hard-boiled egg	¾ C. mayonnaise
1 stalk celery, roughly chopped	2 tsp. sweet pickle relish
	1 T. prepared mustard

Put ham, egg, celery and 2 teaspoons finely chopped onion into a blender or food processor; season with a bit of fresh black pepper. Pulse 20-25 times to mince. Scrape down the sides of the food processor to make sure it all gets combined evenly. Combine mayonnaise, pickle relish, prepared mustard into a separate large bowl. Then stir in minced ham mixture. Cover and chill.
